**Craig's List versus EBay:**

If you have ever wanted to sell your "stuff" online, there are various ways. You are probably aware of EBay. You pay a small listing fee, post a photo and text regarding your item, and set a minimum price. If and when it sells, you pay a percentage fee then ship it out. In general EBay will keep 40-60% of the total investment versus the net you retain. If you price it too high, no one may bid and you've lost your listing fee (you get one new listing if it did not sell). The bright side is your audience is worldwide alongside the millions of others competing for the similar item. Craig's List is free to list and free to sell, but your buyer is local. You will not be mailing your item. This saves lots of fee but again the buyers are limited. You choose. Have fun.

**Wrapping Text in MS Word:**

Just when I thought everyone understood typing in word processing software, I met someone who was missing one important fact. She asked why every time she placed text on a new line the first word was capitalized. When the typewriter was the mode of typing we had to press the return key to go to the next line. When typing in Word, if you press the Enter button you will go to the next line but it understands this as a new paragraph and a new sentence, thus it knows that the beginning of a sentence is always capitalized. Do not press enter when you are typing. If you just type away, the software knows by the margins set, to WRAP around to the next line, completing the sentence or paragraph. Give it a try. Nice!
